

Ingpat has worked with the Environmental Justice Foundation (EJF) on its oceans campaign and human rights since 2019 – focusing on sustainable fisheries and building relationships with small-scale fishing communities. She has been leading EJF’s Net Free Seas project that helps over 300 small-scale fishers in Thailand keep their discarded fishing nets away from the oceans by recycling them into exciting, new products. This involves empowering fishers to participate in a community-based recycling scheme and getting them to join forces with a diverse range of stakeholders including government agencies, recycling industry representatives, and community organizations to tackle marine plastic pollution.
