Most recently with WWF Thailand (Conservation Director 2012-2014) and IUCN (Deputy of Southeast Asia Group 2014-2018), he managed a suite of projects that address biodiversity conservation, sustainability and climate change adaptation in various environment. Petch has been involved with Thailand Marine Plastic issues for the past three years and helped Thai Government hosted [The ASEAN Conference on Reducing Marine Debris in ASEAN Region](#) in November 2017. He co-founded ReReef, an environmental and sustainability enterprise in early 2017. He currently serves as a Technical Advisor for Zoological Society of London (ZSL) Thailand, a Technical Consultant with UNDP and a Marine Program Coordinator for Wildlife Conservation Society (WCS) Thailand. Petch earned his PhD. In marine conservation and management from the Department of Geography, University of Victoria, Canada in 2019.
